vidualized University Studies Program

Students who wish to pursue the Individualized University Studies (IUS) program must apply for and be admitted to the program. The application must include a statement outlining general education objectives that cannot be met

graduate coursework. Applications must be signed by an advisor, the Director of Honors and must be signed by an advisor in the Office of Academic Advisement, the Honors Office faculty member from the student's major department certifying that he or she agrees to the Plan of Study and will serve as the student's IUS adviser until the plan has been completed.

2. The Plan of Study must include a minimum of 12 semester hours, exclusive of courses taken in the student's major department. Projected courses in the Plan of Study are subject to later modification only with the approval of the student's advisor. The Director of Honors will be informed in writing of all changes in the original Plan of Study.

3. It is the student's responsibility to ensure that all prerequisites or requirements for majors are met whether the courses are included in the IUS Plan of Study.

4. Students in teacher education programs need to complete their IUS program to meet state certification requirements. Please confer with personnel in the Office of Teacher Experiences and Certification Processes regarding requirements for teacher education students.
